Youralla Road, Highclere (18kms South of Burnie)

We are holding the first endurance ride of the season at a new venue. Stacey Dodd's Uncle Ernie has kindly offered us the use of his property as a base – hence the name!

This ride will travel straight down Youralla Road for about half a kilometre and then we ride into hundreds of acres of forestry and bush tracks. There are some great scenic tracks with views of Valentine's Peak and beyond.

We are trialling a different format for this ride, with a 20km and a 40km being held on the Friday night. Vetting for this will begin at 12 midday and both the 40km and 20km will start at 3pm. If you would like to enter the 40km or 20km on the Friday AND help TPR or assist BEER to run the ride on the Saturday, we will be discounting your entry fee – so its worth thinking about 😊

On the Saturday we will hold a 40km and 80km ride as per usual. Highclere shop is about 5kms from the ride base, so this will be a great last minute fuel and food stop to get your supplies ready for the ride.
