

Frequently Asked Questions!!!

What do I need to do to enter a 40km ride?

Step 1 You will need complete a [Membership Form](#), entering your details and ticking the Day Membership section. Don't forget to sign the waiver on Page 2 of the Membership Form. Post this form and your cheque to Pat Lamprey, 125 Smith & Others Road, Sassafras, 7307. Phone 6426 7259. Pat is TEERA's Membership Registrar. She will need to receive the form and cheque **NO LESS** than two weeks prior to the 40km ride you'd like to enter. Pat will then post you out a white Day Membership card. Do not lose this card!!

Step 2 Check the TEERA webpage www.aera.asn.au/teera to see when ride entries open. Enter yourself and your horse online. Usually on this page there is also some information about the ride, e.g. whether there is a canteen or if there are any special guidelines such as 'no dogs'. You could also check the [Tasmanian Endurance Riders](#) group on facebook for other updates.

On the day of the ride, you will be issued a ride bib with your number and also a vet card. The vet card will be the record of your ride.

How many 40kms can I do?

You can do as many 40km rides on a day membership as you like. However, the bonus is, if you decide to do an 80km ride, and you have already completed one 40km ride in that year as a day member, you will then receive a discount of \$35 off your full membership.

I would like to enter my first 80km ride. What do I need?

Step 1 You will need to be a full Member to complete an 80km ride. You must also have completed 2 x 40km rides prior to entering your first 80km. Complete the [Membership Form](#). You may like to tick the box to hire a Ride Number at this point. Once you receive your bib, it is yours for the time your TEERA Membership runs from. Post the Membership and your cheque to Pat Lamprey, our Membership Registrar **NO LESS** than two weeks prior to the 80km ride you'd like to enter. Pat will then post you out a blue Novice Rider Membership card. Do not lose this card!!

Step 2 Your horse will need a logbook to complete an 80km ride. Complete the [Novice Endurance Horse Logbook Application](#) which includes an Application for Ownership Label, and return these to Penny Barnes, Logbook Registrar, 15255 Tasman Highway, Cranbrook TAS 7190. Phone 0458 525 378.

Step 3 Check the TEERA webpage www.aera.asn.au/teera to see when ride entries open. Enter yourself and your horse online. Usually on this page there is also some information about the ride, e.g. whether there is a canteen or if there are any special guidelines such as 'no dogs'. You could also check the [Tasmanian Endurance Riders](#) group on facebook for other updates.

I have now completed my 3 x 80kms and my horse is qualified (yaaay!!) What do I do next?

Step 1 You will need complete an [Upgrade to Endurance Application](#). You will also need to complete an Endurance Horse Registration form, which is on page 3 of the application. You can choose to pay \$60 for a lifetime registration or \$20 per year. Remember to make sure to update the Endurance Horse Registration at the beginning of each year if you only pay the \$20.

Step 2 You will need to arrange for a qualified endurance vet to identify your horse. They will fill in the ID pages on the [Upgrade to Endurance Application](#) form. Your horse must be microchipped also. Microchips are available from your vet or can be purchased from Penny Barnes, the Logbook Registrar, for \$20.

Step 3 Once you have arranged for these forms to be completed, send the forms, payments AND your logbook off to Penny Barnes, 15255 Tasman Highway, Cranbrook TAS 7190 – **NO LESS** than two weeks prior to the ride you'd like to enter.

NOTE: Please be aware that if you submit your Membership Application or your Logbook Application to either of the Registrars **any later than two weeks prior to the event, they may not complete your application in time!!!** Best to be organised and get it in early to avoid inconvenience!!
